



A new piston will be incorporated into production on the 440 C.I.D. standard engine late in 1971 production. This piston is lighter than the early piston so requires a new crankshaft. Severe engine vibration will result if the early crankshaft or piston is used in these engines.

The engines will be identified with the letter "C" on the information pad on the top, adjacent to the left bank and tappet rail as follows:
